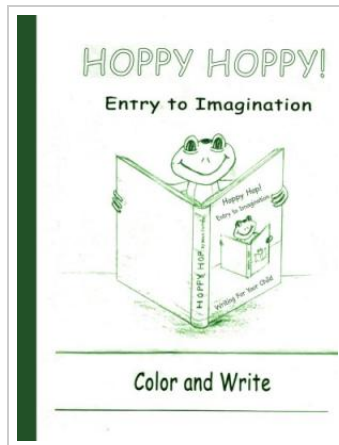




Hoppy Hop
