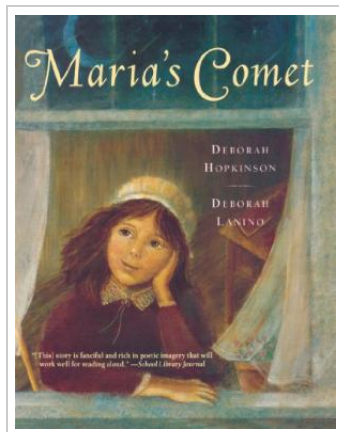




Maria s Comet (Paperback)
