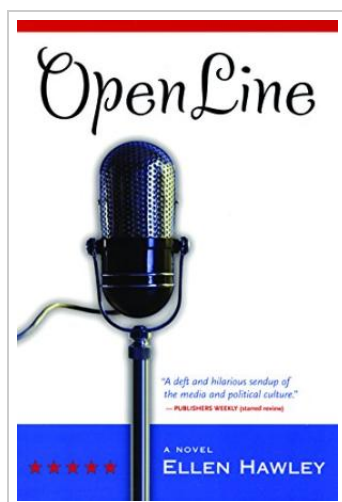




Open Line (Paperback)
