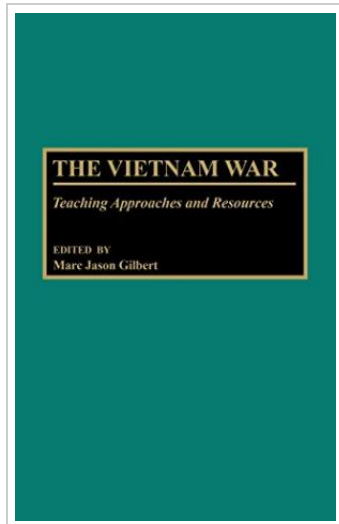




The Vietnam War: Teaching Approaches and Resources (Hardback)
