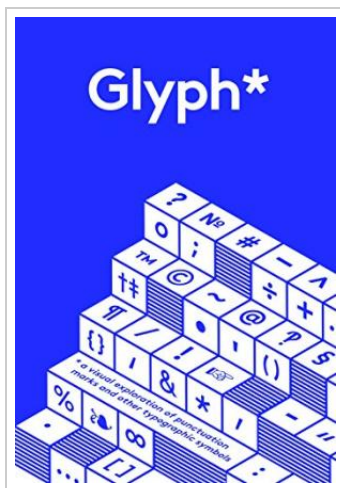




Glyph: A visual exploration of punctuation marks and other typogr (Paperback)
