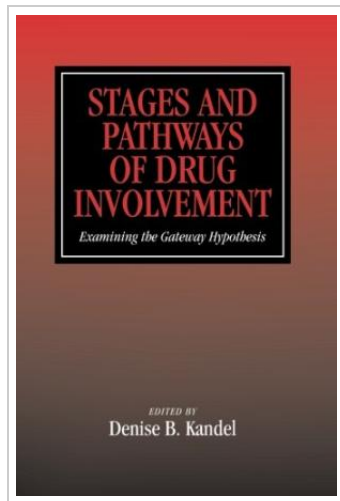




Stages and Pathways of Drug Involvement: Examining the Gateway Hypothesis
