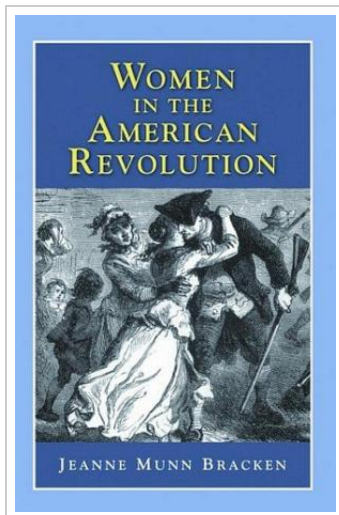




Women in the American Revolution (Paperback)
