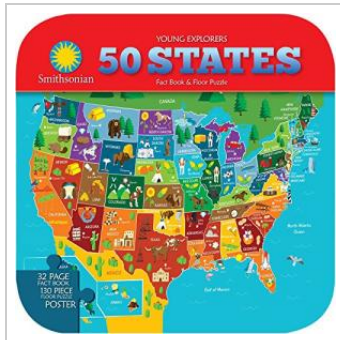




Smithsonian Young Explorers: 50 States
