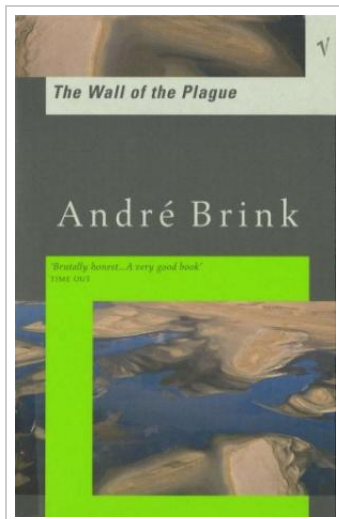




The Wall of the Plague
