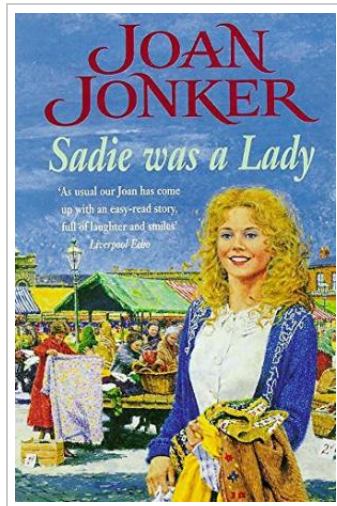




Sadie was a Lady: An engrossing saga of family trouble and true love (Paperback)
