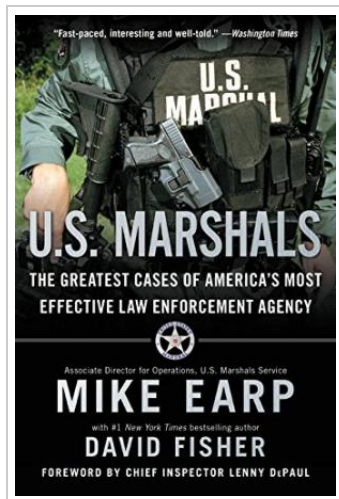



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U.S. Marshals: The Greatest Cases of America's Most Effective Law Enforcement Agency (Paperback)
