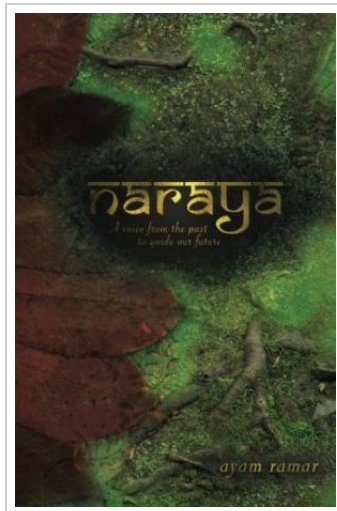




Naraya: A Voice from the Past to Guide Our Future (Paperback)
