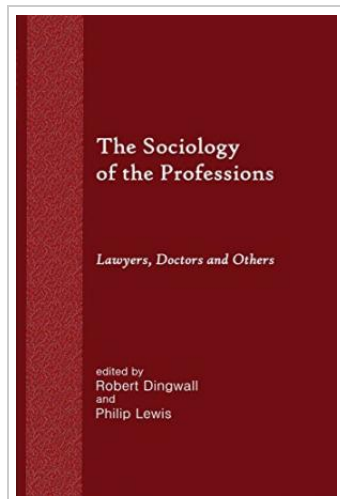



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The Sociology of the Professions: Lawyers, Doctors and Others
