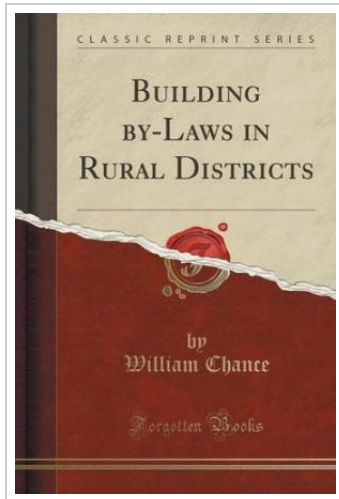




Building By-Laws in Rural Districts (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)

It occurred to me that it might serve a useful purpose to publish it together with the text of a Bill on the subject, which passed through the House of Lords without any opposition whatever in 1906, and with a revised Code of Building By-laws for Rural Districts, both Bill and Code being now out of print. The latter was drafted by an experienced and well-known architect and seemed to many people to be a great improvement in many ways on the existing Rural Code of the Local Government Board. In order to make the differences between the two Codes easily intelligible I have added to the text those clauses of the existing Model which are omitted altogether in the Revised Code or substantially altered by it.
