EPA 1999) Emerging technologies typically follow a development process that leads from laboratory and bench-scale investigations to pilot studies and, subsequently, to initial use or full-scale demonstrations before the technology is considered established. Not all technologies survive the entire development process. Some fail in the laboratory or at pilot stages; others see limited application in the field, but poor performance, complications, or unexpected costs may cause them to lose favor. Even technologies that become established may lose favor in time, as technological advances lead to obsolescence. In short, technologies are subject to the same evolutionary forces present in nature; those that cannot meet the demands of their environment fail, while those that adapt to changing technological,...



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
