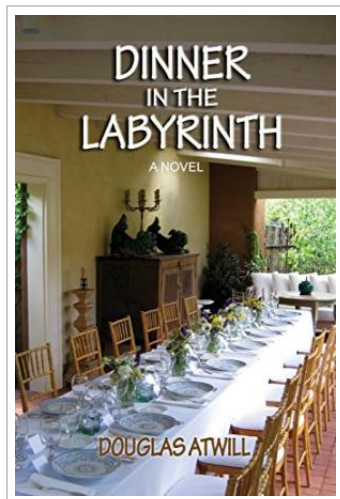




Dinner in the Labyrinth: [A Novel] (Paperback)
