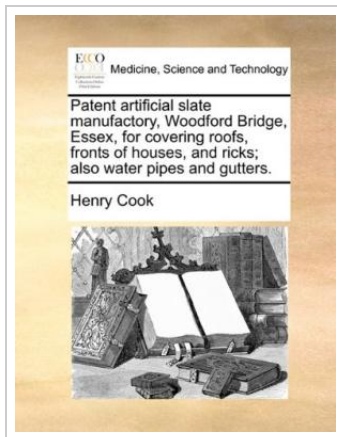




Patent artificial slate manufactory, Woodford Bridge, Essex, for covering roofs, fronts of houses, and ricks also water pipes and gutters.
