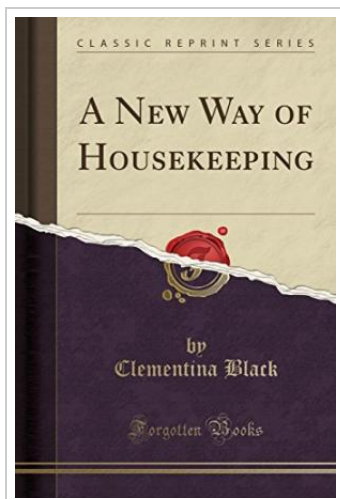




A New Way of Housekeeping (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)
