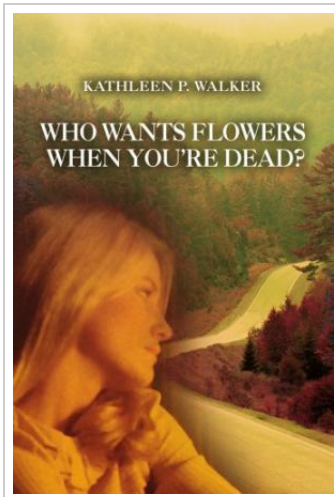




Who Wants Flowers When You re Dead?
