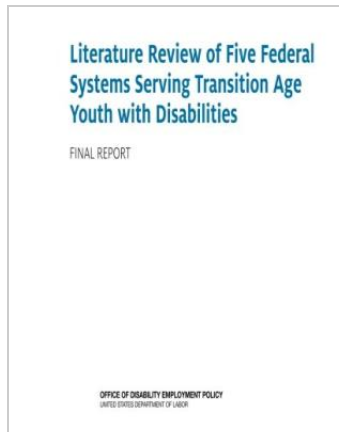




Literature Review of Five Federal Systems Serving Transition Age Youth with Disabilities

The book was limited to these five systems, rather than examining all of the systems that serve this population, due to financial constraints. This document summarizes each system s role, the extent of its use by the population, and central programs and authorizing legislation. In addition, challenges and recommendations for each system are identified, as are common themes and trends across systems.
