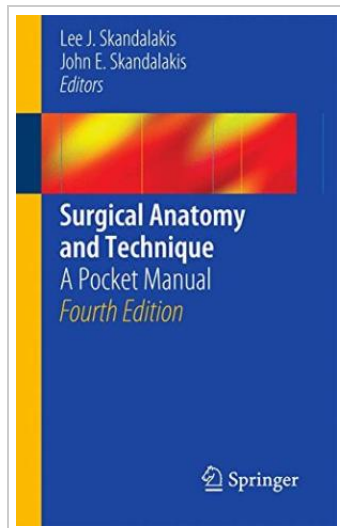




Surgical Anatomy and Technique: A Pocket Manual (Paperback)
