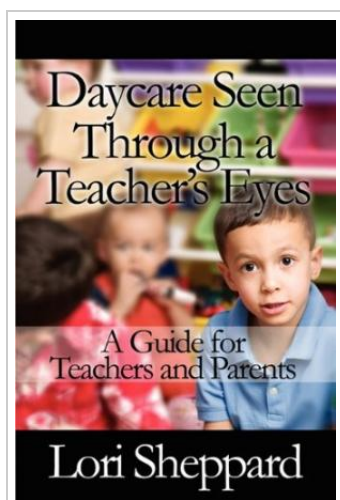




Daycare Seen Through a Teacher's Eyes: A Guide for Teachers and Parents
