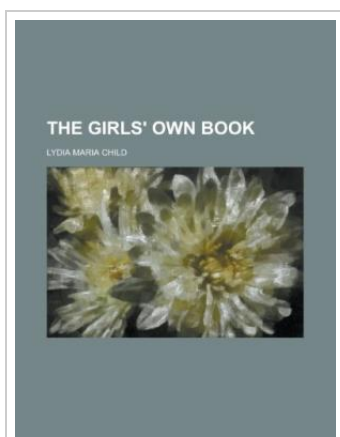




## The girls own book

A sheet of fine letter-paper placed behind it, and both held up to the light, produces the same, or a better effect PAPER LANDSCAPES. Observe well the shadows of the picture you wish to copy, draw their shape as exactly as you can, and cut them out. Paste these pieces on a sheet of paper, in such places as they...
