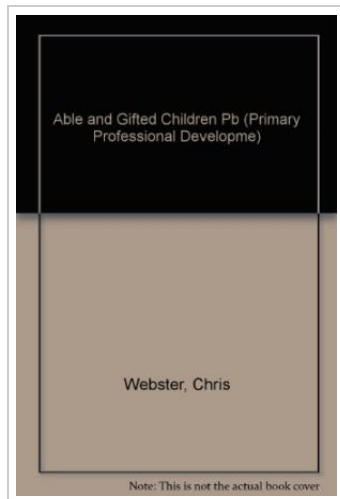




Able and Gifted Children (Primary Professional Development)
