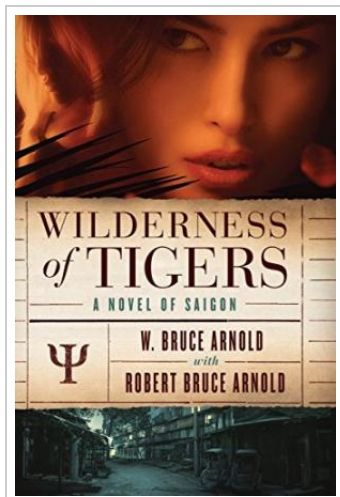




Wilderness of Tigers: A Novel of Saigon
