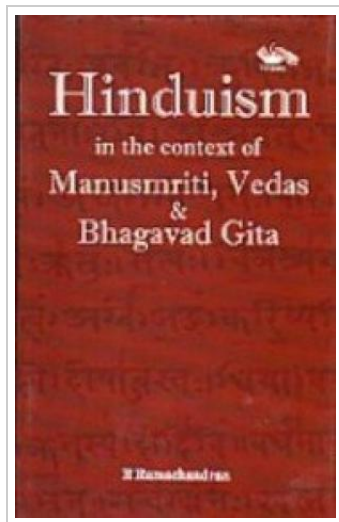




Hinduism In the context of Manusmriti, Vedas and Bhagavad Gita
