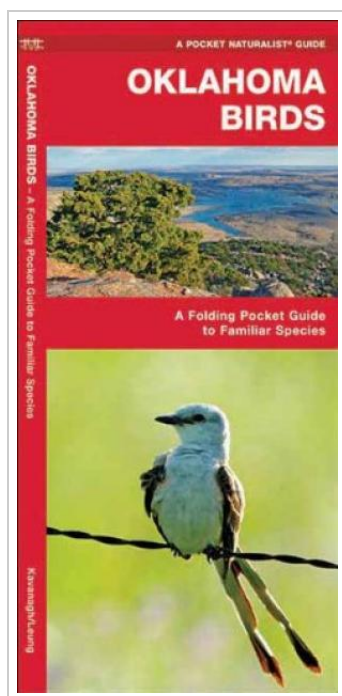




Oklahoma Birds: A Folding Pocket Guide to Familiar Species
