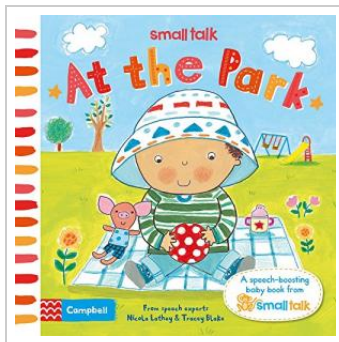




Small Talk: at the Park: A First Book About Language for Babies
