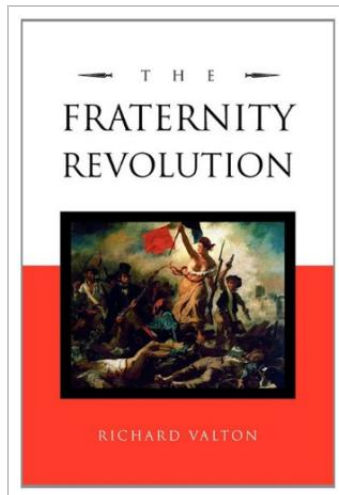




The Fraternity Revolution
