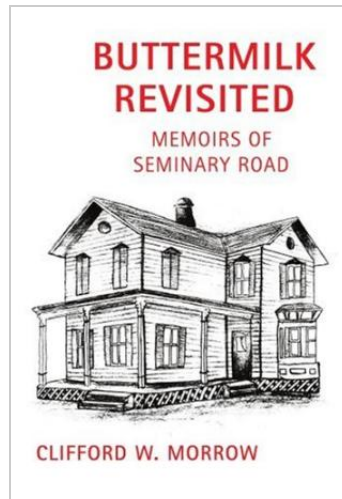




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Buttermilk Revisited: Memoirs of Seminary Road (Paperback)
