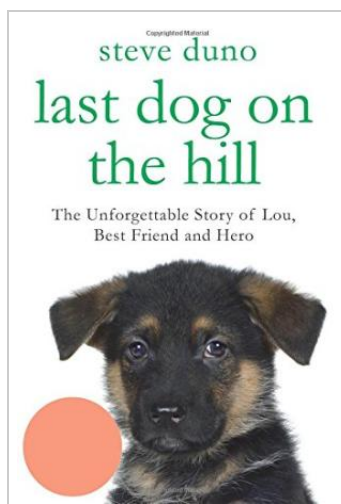




Last Dog on the Hill (Unabridged)
