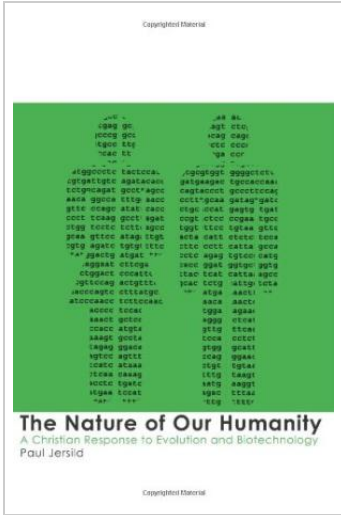




The Nature of Our Humanity: The Ethics in Genetics and Biotechnology
