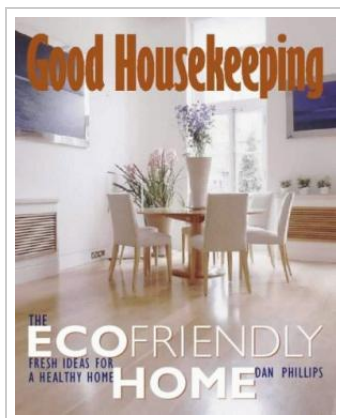




## The Ecofriendly Home (Hardback)
