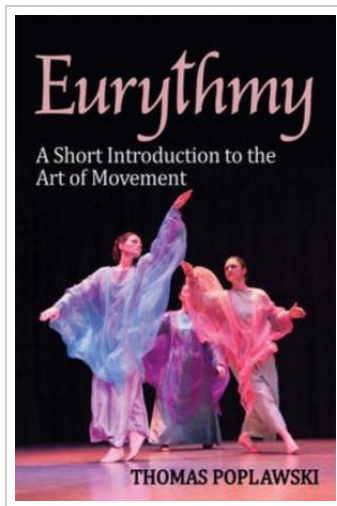




Eurythmy: A Short Introduction to the Art of Movement (2nd Revised edition)
