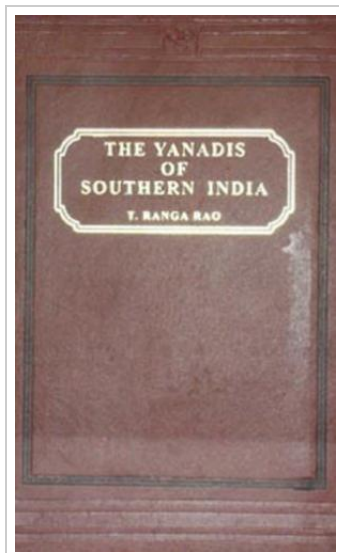




## The Yanadis of Southern India
