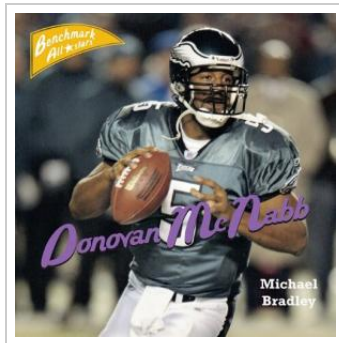




Donovan McNabb (Hardback)
