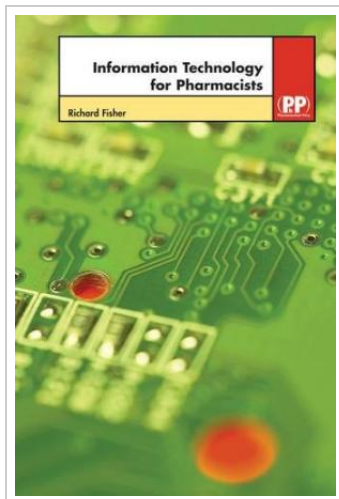




Information Technology for Pharmacists (Paperback)
