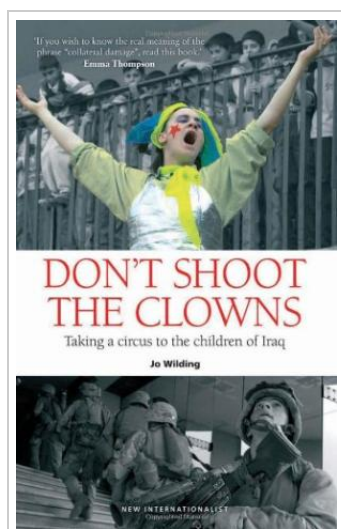



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Don't Shoot the Clowns: Taking a Circus to the Real Iraq

'This is the first time since the war that I have seen the children laugh this way, from their insides.' Jo Wilding isn't a journalist looking for stories.
