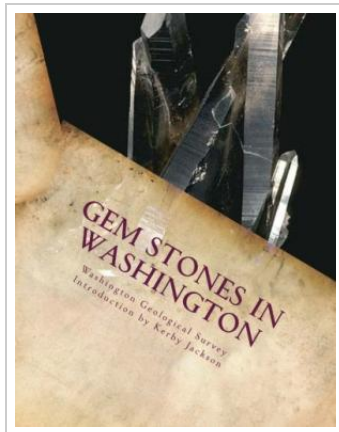




Gem Stones in Washington (Paperback)
