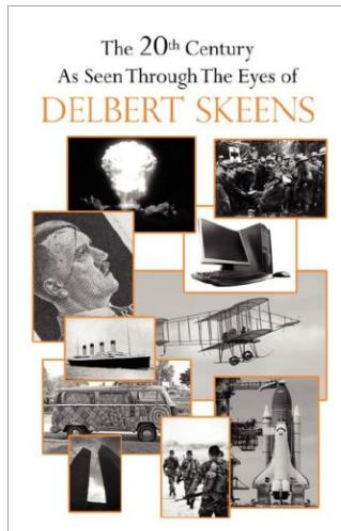




The 20th Century As Seen Through The Eyes of Delbert Skeens
