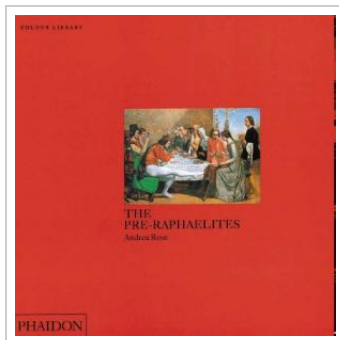




The Pre-Raphaelites (Paperback)
