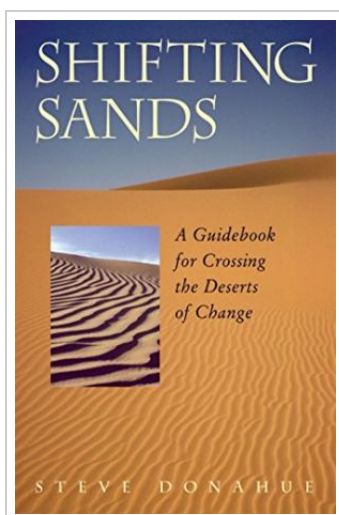




Shifting Sands - A Guidebook for Crossing the Deserts of Change (Paperback)
