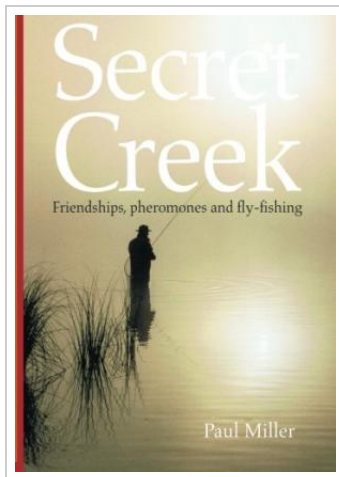




Secret Creek: Friendships, Pheromones and Fly-Fishing
