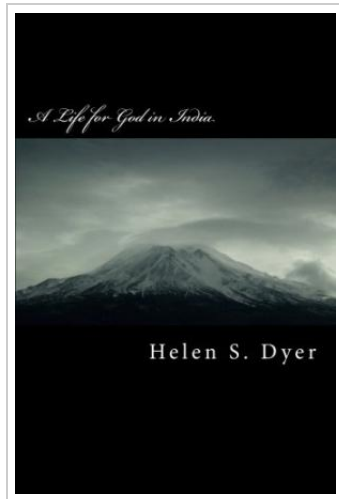




A Life for God in India: Memorials of Mrs. Jennie Fuller of Akola and Bombay
