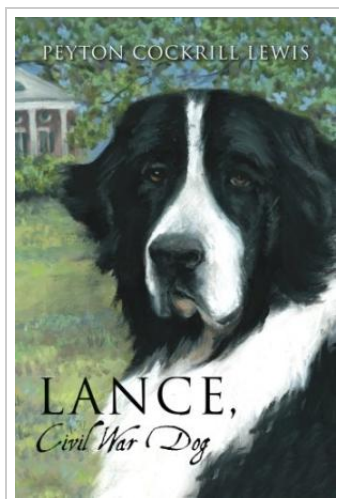




Lance, Civil War Dog (Paperback)
