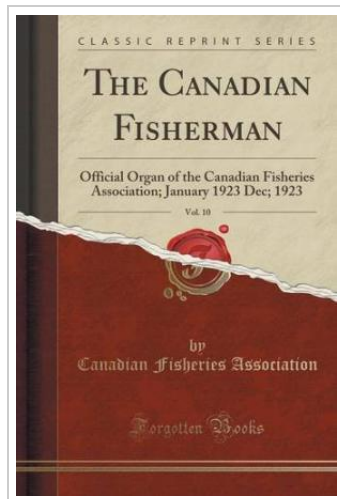

J. E. Perrault, minister of colonization, mines and fisheries, had approved by the Quebec legislature last month, indicates an honest desire to promote the advancement of the industry. The legislation adopted is permissive in its character, that is, it permits the minister of fisheries to do certain things, but there is no obligation to carry out the policy either in whole or in part. Should he discover, upon mature investigation, that a certain phase of his programme will not accomplish the end for which it was designed, he need not proceed with it. What the legislature has adopted commits the government to nothing and in having it so, the Hon. Mr. Perrault exhibited considerable wisdom.
