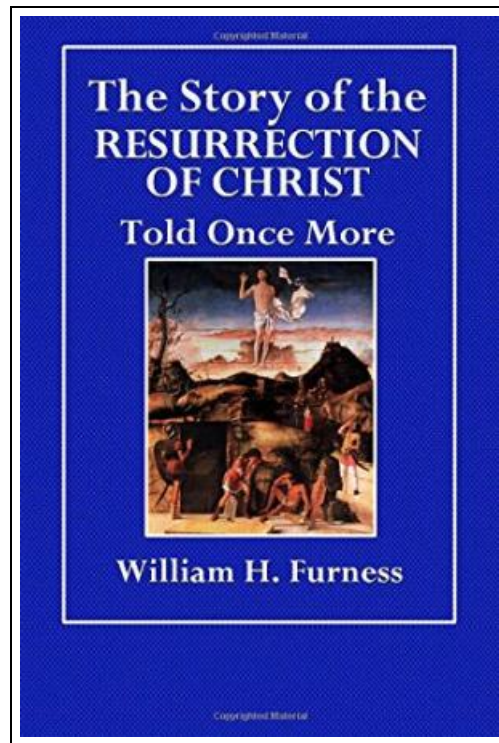

Over the whole book is shed the charm of a beautiful spirit, repeating in simplicity and affection its often-offered tribute to the greatest man of men. If tender and loving faith of the purest strain could alone convince one of the reality of the gospel narratives of Jesus' actual reappearance alive in the flesh to Mary, Dr. Furness would win an easy triumph over our critical hesitations. But, when he says that nothing in the Gospels is proved, nothing in all the world; that all is an illusion, if such a reappearance is not proved; and that, if Jesus had not awoke from the dead, his memory would have faded away from the world into an unsubstantial dream of the past, he arouses reasonings that are not easily satisfied. If this last assertion is true, why does Dr. Furness say, concerning the Gospels as a whole, Great things said and done strike all who hear and behold them; and hearers and beholders there always are who must publish what they have heard and seen, or die? If this be so, and true it is, how could the memory of Jesus' life have perished, if he had not risen from the dead? Apart from this general inconsistency of view, however, Dr. Furness here emphasizes again his favorite idea that it was not an angel,...



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
