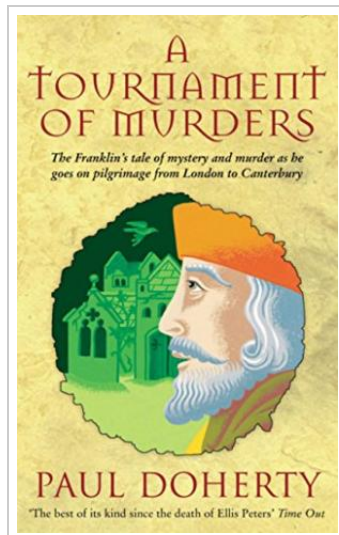




A Tournament of Murders
