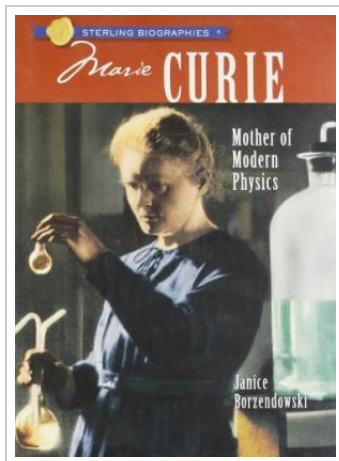




Marie Curie: Mother of Modern Physics
