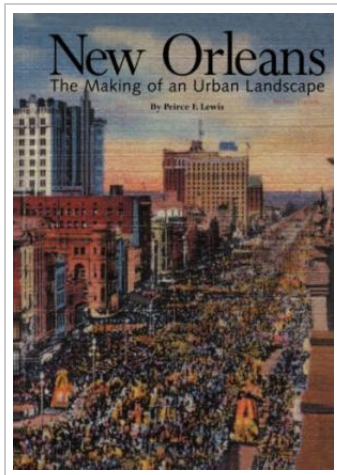




New Orleans: The Making of an Urban Landscape
